1. What does the abbreviation MDF stand for?
2. What does the abbreviation HMR stand for?
3. What is the purpose of a scoring saw or scriber?
4. What does the abbreviation NC stand for in relation to the beam saw?
5. Emergency stop buttons are coloured green and flush with the surface of the control panel. True or False
6. Emergency stop buttons are coloured red and are raised from the surface of the control panel. True or False
7. What is best practice in relation to the positioning of the saw guards?
8. State the Australian Standard (name and code) that relates to static machine guards.
9. What is the 'kerf' of a blade?
10. Draw a cutting plan for:  
five doors 700 mm x 500 mm  
four drawer fronts 150 mm x 500 mm  
Material size is 2400 mm x 1200 mm with timber grain surface.
