Set out on the following page are examples of the types of questions that your assessor might ask you when assessing you for recognition of prior learning in the competency: LMFFM3020B Set up, operate and maintain sawing machines.

1. It is essential for the machine operator or assistant to use correct and safe lifting and handling procedures when using machines. Explain these procedures.
2. Name the five (5) main types of circular cross cut sawing machines.
3. Name four (4) reasons for using a throating piece on a circular rip saw.
4. A circular rip saw blade hook angle may range between what two angles?
5. When cutting solid timber, what is the recommended rim speed range to use for most circular saws?
6. In which direction does the spindle nut on a circular sawing machine undo in relation to the saw blade rotation?
7. There are three (3) positioning requirements for a riving knife that is set in relation to a saw blade, explain them.
8. When operating a circular cross cut saw to cut bowed timber, which way should the rounded face be placed in relation to the table surface?
9. When operating a sliding table panel saw and the material jams in the saw blade, what are the possible causes for this and how do you rectify these problems?
10. Name two (2) methods of joining scroll band saw blades.
